### **Leadership Steamboat Additional Information:**

- \$100 deposit is due with the application which will be put toward the total payment, the balance is due September 22, 2017. A payment plan is available but arrangements must be made in advance. If full payment is not received by the agreed upon date, students will be terminated from the course. Checks should be made payable to SSCRA / Leadership. Applicants requiring some financial aid for the program fees should submit a statement of need to be included with the application
- Attendance is mandatory at all events and programming (except the Economic Summit). Your attendance will be reported to your employer or sponsoring organization however, two excused absences will be allowed. Most days will last until 5:00 p.m. and early exits are detrimental to the guests presenters and group project coordination. Make-up assignments will be required for any unexcused absence. Individual projects must be completed for students to graduate from the course.
